

**NOTICE OF INTENDED DECISION FOR AWARD OF CONTRACT -
PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES:
FILTER COVERS CONSTRUCTION PHASE SERVICES**

Recommended Action -

Motion to approve Professional Services Evaluation Committee recommendation and authorize the Executive Director to execute the negotiated contract, scope and fee for Professional Engineering Services to perform and complete the Filter Covers Construction Phase Services Project.

Statements of Qualification were requested from consultants for the purpose of providing ‘Professional Engineering Services’ to perform and complete the Filter Covers Construction Phase Services Project in accordance with the Authority’s Procurement Policy. One (1) Statement of Qualification was timely received by the March 21, 2019 submittal deadline and was evaluated and ranked by the Authority’s Professional Services Evaluation Committee (PSEC) in accordance with the Authority Procurement Policy.

Staff recommends that the Executive Director approve the PSEC ranking and recommendation, and negotiate a contract, scope and fee for ‘Professional Engineering Services’ to perform and complete the Authority’s ‘Filter Covers Construction Phase Services Project’ with TKW Consulting Engineer’s Inc. The negotiated contract, scope and fee will be presented to the Authority Board for consideration at a future Board meeting.
